Philip Caggiano's new furniture collection showcases 15 functional art masterpieces. Highlights include:

**Xosted Lounge-** Curated from stainless steel S304 exhaust pipe tubing, this useable sculpture requires 300 hours of hand polishing to achieve its mirror finish.

**Daytona Lounge** is exquisitely formed from the seat pattern of the Ferrari Daytona Coupe 1971. With hand-waxed whiskey brown leather imported from Italy, custom Alcoa aluminum, and a gorgeous mid-century modern finish.

**F1 Carbon Fiber Lounge** takes its cues from the speed and sleekness of the racetrack and can be customized to match any color palette.

The entire collection is handcrafted utilizing only the highest quality materials: carbon fiber, stainless steel, bronze, gold, leather, textiles, exotic wood, aluminum, brass and precious stone. The contemporary furniture collection ranges from \$4,995 to \$80,000. The median price range is \$7,500-\$15,000.

The Philip Caggiano furniture collection appeals to a wide range of male and female clients, including modern design enthusiasts; young tech-savvy entrepreneurs;



established CEOs; fashionable socialites; and aficionados of exotic and vintage cars, private planes, race boats, and custom timepieces.

Working exclusively with giants of the supercar industry, Caggiano curated a range of performance-enhancing products for some of the world's most powerful and prestigious supercars. Caggiano's proximity to Ferrari, Porsche, Lamborghini, Bentley and Aston Martin, fueled his red-hot passion for shape, color, texture and material. Self-taught in every facet, with a penchant for the art of overbuilding solid signature styles that never go out of fashion, Caggiano captures the visual drama needed for a statement piece of art. He's a designer mesmerized by texture, the touch of soft leather, the roar of an Italian V12 engine, and the exhilarating thrill of speed.

For Philip Caggiano, life in the fast lane included refurbishing multi-million dollar vintage and professional race cars, such as an \$11 million Ferrari, a 1957 California Spyder SWB, rare Lamborghini Reventons and \$3 million Lamborghini Miuras. "I conceptualized my Slyde lounge chair while driving 160 mph in a 1965 Ford GT race car at Sebring," said Philip Caggiano, designer, fabricator and president of his eponymous design firm located in Westchester, NY.
